PE lessons

So we are three weeks into the term and it has been fantastic to see the enthusiasm and passion from the children regarding PE and Sport and I look forward to seeing this continue to grow over the course of the school year. With this in mind it is important to make sure that children are safe throughout and are dressed appropriately. Please can parents/carers note the following points regarding our **PE uniform policy**:

Footwear: Trainers/sports shoes must be worn on PE days rather than their school shoes.

Earrings/Jewelry: These should be removed for PE lessons, if your child is unable to remove them, they should then be taped up on the front and back. Micropore and Zinc Oxide tapes are suitable and available from Boots/Superdrug's.

Watches: These should also be removed prior to the lesson.

Further to this, if your child is unable to participate in a lesson due to illness, they should bring a signed note, and should still attend school in their PE kit as they will be taking part in the lesson in a non-practical capacity, e.g. Umpire or Assistance Coach.
