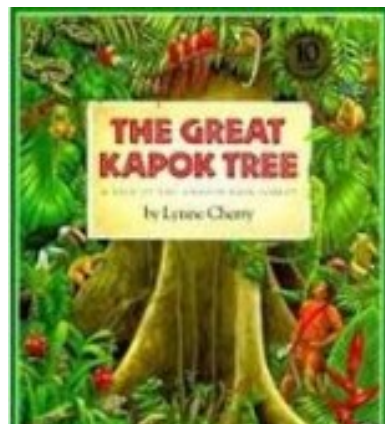
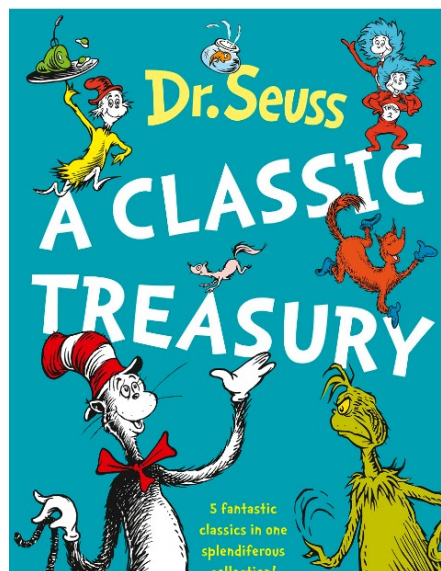




The Haven Spring Two 2023
