

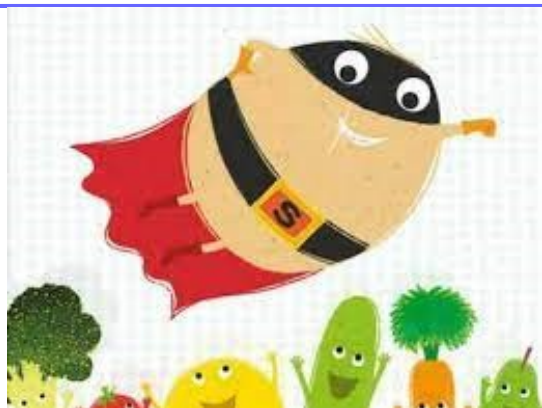


## Everyday Superheroes
