


# The Haven Autumn 2023

### Maths

### **Dolphins**

Within our Maths Curriculum we will be working on different elements depending on the children and their starting point. Within all the areas of the curriculum the children will work on their problem solving skills which will include them being able to explain why an answer is correct.

In the first half term, this will include place value for numbers within 10 for some of us extending to numbers within 100 for others. We will then be using these numbers to help us to solve problems with addition and subtraction.

In the second half term, we will continue to work on our addition and subtraction knowledge as well as learning about shapes.

In all of our Maths lessons, we will be using concrete resources to support the children and their learning will be enhanced by working in small groups supported by an adult. There will be a big focus on the vocabulary of all concepts taught and these are revisit-
