Year Four Autumn Term 2 2023 — Topic One

As Writers:

We will create their own travel brochures as well as read and explore 'Leo and the Gorgon's Curse'. The children will spend time creating their own quests where they will discover their very own mythological creature. Within our writing we will be focusing on:

- Using fronted adverbials to vary our sentences
- Direct speech to create dialogue between characters
- Expanded noun phrases to improve our description of characters and their surroundings.

As Geographers:

We will be learning about the location and characteristics of the Alps. We will be exploring:

- What life is like in the Alps
- Where are they located?
- The physical and human characteristics of the Alps and alpine region
- Using world maps—locating continents and mountainous regions

As Artists:

We will be learning about Ancient Greek art and pottery and using clay, the children will design and create their very own Ancient Greek inspired clay pot.

As Scientists:

We will be learning about sound by taking part in a variety of investigations. We will be covering:

- How sound is made?
- How it travels?
- Pitch and volume
- The different parts of the ear and how it allows us to hear different pitches and volumes over a range of distances

In Computing:

We will be using a different programme to create media and audio production. We will be:

- Recording sounds using the chromebooks
- Learning new audio editing skills
