



Year 3 - Spring Two 2024

As Readers: We will explore a non-fiction text that links to our science learning of rocks, a book called 'The Pebble in my Pocket'. We will read a fictional story called 'Leonora Bolt: secret inventor', a story about a female lead who is courageous and resilient in her quest to become an inventor.

As Writers: We will use our text 'Escape from Pompeii' to inspire our narrative writing. We will research natural disasters and plan our own suspense narrative. Following this, we will become News reporters and create a Newsflash reporting on the volcanic eruption in Pompeii.

As Mathematicians: We will look at a range of fractions in shapes and number; find fractions of amounts and add and subtract fractions. We will look at length: converting between units and carry out practical activities.

As Scientists: We will explore the life-cycle of rocks. We will use skills of observation and classification to sort rocks based on appearance & physical properties. We will discover how fossils are formed.

As Geographers: We will continue to explore our local area of Woking and compare it to St Ives in Cornwall. We will carry out an enquiry and build a questionnaire to see how we can improve Woking.

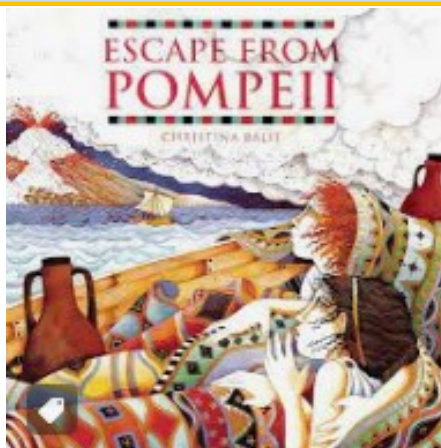
