Within our Maths Curriculum, we will be working on different elements depending on the children and their starting point. Within all the areas of the curriculum the children will work on their problem solving skills which will include them being able to explain why an answer is correct.

In the first half term, this will include number facts, halving and quartering, and position and direction for some. For others, we will be learning about fractions, money, and time.

In the second half term, those who haven't already will be doing shape, time and money, and the others will be doing shape, statistics, and multiplication and division.

In all of our Maths lessons, we will be using concrete resources to support the children and their learning will be enhanced by working in small groups supported by an adult. There will be a big focus on the vocabulary of all concepts taught and these are revisit-

Whales

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

During Summer Term 1 we will be focusing on learning about stories inspired by picture books from the USA. We will primarily use "Where the Wild Things Are" to help us to write our version of the story.

Following this, in Summer Term 2, we will use "Maisie's Dragon" by Phillipa Danvers to help us to write a recount of an imaginary event.
