As Readers: We will be reading, exploring and inferring from a new text: The Girl Who Stole an Elephant by Nizrana Farook.

As Writers: We will be reviewing our understanding of a range of grammatical features including fronted adverbials, prepositions, conjunctions, tenses and using the correct punctuation for direct speech. We will be developing our skills to write an explanation text based on the text we are reading as a class as well as a diary entry written from the perspective of a cacao bean.

As **Mathematicians**: We will continue to develop of understanding of decimals before moving onto learning about measurements including applying our knowledge of decimals within money and telling the time on both analogue and digital clocks.

As Scientists: We will be looking at the States of Matters (solids, liquids and gases) and exploring the properties of each. We will then investigate the water cycle and why it is so important.
