As Readers: We will be reading, exploring and inferring from 2 new texts: 'The Wreck of Zanzibar' by Michael Morpurgo and 'How to Train your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell.

As Writers: We will be writing a narrative including expanded noun phrases, short sentences for dramatic effect and dialogue between characters. We will then create a persuasive piece of writing relating to deforestation using the text, 'The Great Kapok Tree' to support and inspire us.

As Scientists: We will be grouping living things in a variety of ways, using classification keys. We will then move onto identifying different types of habitat, learning how animals adapt to their environment and identifying food chains within different habitats.

As Geographers: We will be identifying different biomes of the world, locating rainforests on a world map (using the equator and tropics as reference points) and understanding more about climate and habitats in different areas of the world. We will also explore our understanding of the effect of deforestation on the rainforest and the rest of the world, identifying rainforest products we use in our everyday lives and the impact that these have on the rainforest environment.

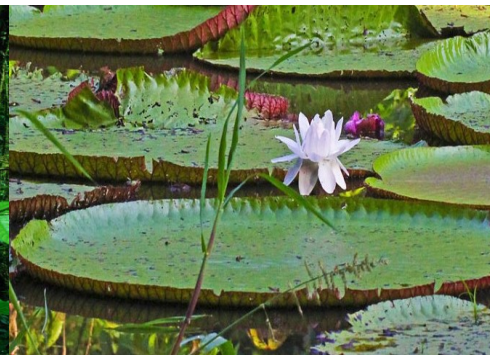
As Designers: We will designing and creating our very own bridges, focusing on various design factors to ensure our bridge is strong and stable.
