Value of the half term: Respect

As **Readers and Writers:** We will read some famous Ancient Greek myths and we will be using these texts to help us write a description of a maze based on Theseus and the Minotaur; write a play script and finishing off with a quest based on a myth; use figurative language and a range of sentence structures to write a myth and use our inference, retrieval and prediction skills to demonstrate our understanding of the characters and plots within the myths.

As **Mathematicians:** We will be reviewing and demonstrating our understanding of place value including counting in 1000s, rounding to the nearest 10 and 100, recognising the place value of 4 digit numbers and using a number line correctly.

As **Historians**: We will be learning about the three main periods of the Stone Age, the Bronze Age and the Iron Age, and what life was like in each of them. We will also learn about Skara Brae and Stonehenge and how this is still relevant to our lives now.

As **Scientists**: We will become electricians, learning through a number of practical lessons. We will cover what appliances use mains or battery power, the key components of a simple circuit, how switches work, identify common conductors and insulators and how to stay safe when using electricity.

As **Artists:** We will be looking at the work of Henri Rousseau and using features of his work to create our own paintings and collage including hidden animals within our artwork.
