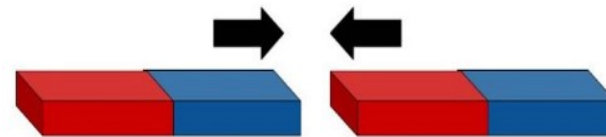
As **Writers** we will be inspired by *The Railway Children* by E. Nesbit to write letters from a character's point of view and read examples of diary extracts before writing our own diary entries.

As **Mathematicians** we will continue improving speed of recall of our times tables, using arrays, numberlines and repeated addition to represent our working.

As **Scientists** we will investigate magnetic materials; explore forces of attraction and repulsion; use scientific skills to make predictions, ask relevant questions and use different types of scientific enquiries to answer them.

As **Designers/Artists** we will explore how climate affects food growth, compare seasonal ingredients, create a healthy recipe using and cook (and taste) our very own seasonal tarts.

As **Historians** we will be learning about the three main periods of the Stone Age, the Bronze Age and the Iron Age, and what life was like in each of them. We will also learn about Skara Brae and Stonehenge and how this is still relevant to our lives now.
