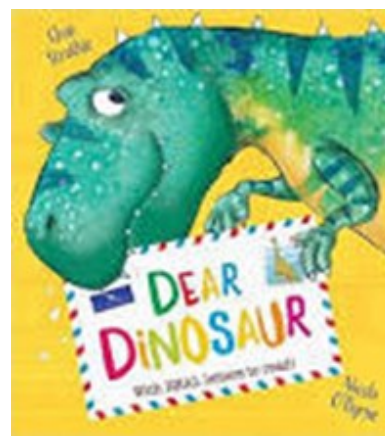




Footprints from the Past

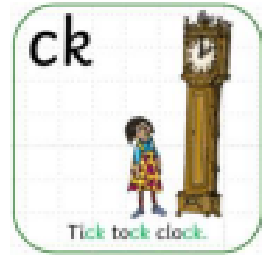
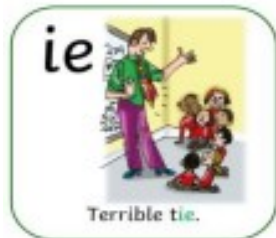
We will continue to develop our key skills of:
