Value of the half term: Courage

As **Readers** we will be focusing on Shakespeare this half term. We will be reading abridged versions of *Romeo and Juliet* and *Macbeth*.

As **Writers** we will be exploring *A Midsummer's Nights Dream* and using this to inspire our writing of play scripts. We will then be looking at *Hamlet* and using this to inspire our narrative writing.

As **Mathematicians** we will be focusing on Geometry. Will be learning to measure and draw angles accurately, calculate angles on a straight line and angles around a point. We will then be learning to read and plot coordinates, and translate and reflect shapes.

As **Scientist** we will be learning about the functions of different parts of a plant. We will then be exploring the life cycles of different animals.

As Artists we will be exploring the work of Frida Kahlo, with a focus on developing our painting skills.

As **Historians** we will be exploring what life was like in Tudor England. Our trip to Hampton Court Palace will enable the children to learn more about the lives of Henry VIII and his wives as they explore the palace.

As **Linguists** we will be learning how to discuss habitats in Spanish. We will be presenting both orally and in written form about various plants and animals that live in five very different habitats.
