

# Christmas lunch on Wednesday 17 December

We are pleased to be offering our Christmas lunch on Wednesday 17 December, you should have received a copy of this special menu by email. Please note there is an earlier **cut off to order this by Friday 21st November** to allow the kitchen time to order the extra food required. This is usually a very festive occasion and we would love as many of the children to join us in having the school lunch as possible.

If your child decides they would prefer a packed lunch from home on any day that you have ordered a school lunch please let us know by emailing <a href="mailto:lunches@goldsworthprimary.co.uk">lunches@goldsworthprimary.co.uk</a> by 9.30am so that we may cancel their order, avoid food wastage and you being charged for the meal.

#### **Packed Lunches**

Eating a healthy, balanced lunch is essential to ensure children have the right nutrients and enough energy to see them through the school day. It can also positively affect children's behaviour in the classroom thereby making learning easier.

As we are a nut free school please ensure foods containing **nuts are NOT brought into school at all**, either as part of a packed lunch or snack. Please also ensure that your child is able to open their lunchbox/food flask by themselves and that you provide any cutlery they may need to eat their lunch – school cutlery is not available for use.

Please also remember to cut small round foods (grapes, strawberries, cherry tomatoes, etc) lengthways and large fruits (such as melon) and any hard fruit or vegetables (raw apple and carrot) into slices and not small chunks.
