As **readers**, we will continue to work on our comprehension skills and understanding through our reading of *Hilda and The Bird Parade* by Luke Pearson.

As **writers**, we will use our text 'Escape from Pompeii' to inspire our narrative writing. We will be focusing on including dialogue to move a story on and using conjunctions to express time, place and cause.

As **mathematicians**, we will be learning about capacity using millilitres and litres and converting between the two as well as continuing our work on fractions. We will also learn how to convert, add and subtract pounds (£) and pence (p).

As **artists**, we will discover the work of William Morris and explore repeated patterns. We will make our own printing block and make repeated patterns using paint.

As **scientists**, we will ask questions and carry out investigations to find out why animals including humans need to eat, understand the main food groups, and what makes a healthy diet.

As **historians** we will be exploring the strength and success of the Roman Army, and their impact on life in Britain, both in History and today.

In **RE**, we will be studying key milestones in the lives of the Jewish community. Children will cover Bar and Bat Mitzvahs, marriage, Passover (pesach) and other foot festivals.
