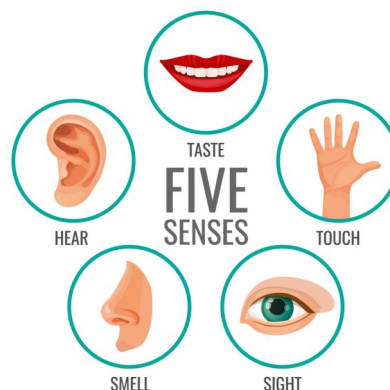
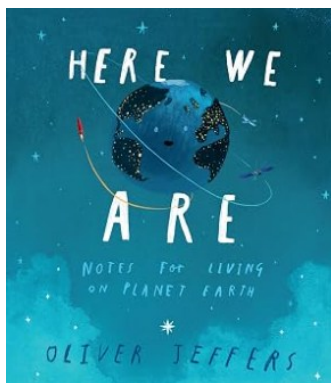




All About Me and My World

The Big Idea – What is our school like?

Our school is a wonderful place, and this term the children will become explorers as they discover all it has to offer. Using maps and aerial photographs, they will learn how to navigate around the school and develop their understanding of the local environment.

As **Readers**, we will access a range of texts through our Drawing Club writing programme. We will begin by exploring stories about animals and our class mascots. Our core texts this term will be 'Coming to England' and 'Here We Are'. We will use story language to retell the story and build vocabulary, and explore features of non-fiction texts.

As **Writers**, we will learn to use capital letters and full stops to write simple sentences. We will apply phonic skills to spell new words.

As **Mathematicians**, we will build our understanding of number and place value within 10. We will learn to name and describe 2D and 3D shapes.

As **Geographers**, we will be learning simple map work skills. We will explore our school.

As **Scientists**, we will learn about the human body, labelling body parts and exploring our 5 senses.

As **Artists**, we will learn to colour mix, explore shape and line in Kandisky's art, to apply in our own pieces of work.

In **PSHE**, we will learn about our feelings and relationships.

In **Music**, we will learn to keep a steady beat and respond to high and low pitches.

In **RE**, we will explore the question: Why do Christians call God 'Creator'?

In **Computing**, we will learn about technology around us. We will learn about online safety.
